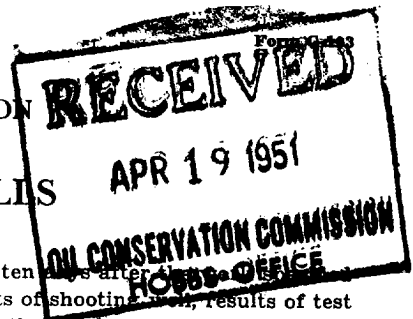

After waiting 36 hours, the casing was tested with 1000# pressure; there was no drop in pressure. Drilled plug at 5:00 a.m. April 16, 1951, and tested the cement with 1000# pressure. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
