Dear Mr. Macey:

John M. Kelly hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the 1/4NE, 1/4SW, E3/4W of Section 16, T-19-S, R-37-E, Mumont Gas Field, Lea County, and its support thereof states the following:

1. John M. Kelly is the owner and operator of oil and gas leases known as Humble State Lease Block which comprises the 1/4NE, 1/4SW, E3/4W of Section 16, T-19-S, R-37-E.
2. The Humble State #1 well is located 1930 feet from the south and 1930 feet from the west lines of Section 16, and was completed January 1, 1955, at a depth of 3850 feet as a gas well in the Mumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order K-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
