DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

DUPLICATE

This well spudded 6-13-36 and drilled to depth of 57' that date in surface sand & caliche. Two States Drilling Co. contractors.

June 15, 1936, well drilled to total depth of 271' in redbed. 10-3/4" OD 40.50# SH LW casing was set at 267' and cemented with 200 sacks.

June 17, 1936. 10-3/4" casing was tested with 1200# pressure for 30 minutes before drilling plug. After drilling plug, pipe was again tested with 1200# pressure for 30 minutes. Pipe tested OK.
