Set cast iron plug at 3790° with one sack cement on top of plug. Perforate 5 1/2" casing at selected intervals, 2460 to 3746°. Treated perforated intervals selectively with 1500 gallons of acid and 20,000 gallons of lease crude using 1# of sand and 1/10# adomite per gallon.
