The Texas Company therefore requests the Oil Conservation Commission to grant an administrative non-standard production order under Rule 5B of Order R-520 as soon as the waivers are received from Amerada and Gulf.

Under Date No. 1 was a new bill introduced by Mr. B. F. Smith of the House of Representatives. It was entitled "An Act to amend the State Tax Law so as to provide for the collection of a tax on the manufacture and sale of all articles of apparel and clothing, and to appropriate the same for the support of the public schools." The bill was referred to the Committee on Education, and after being considered by that committee, was reported back to the House of Representatives, with a report favoring its passage. The bill was then passed by the House of Representatives, and was sent to the Senate for consideration. The Senate also passed the bill, and it was signed into law by Governor Smith on March 12, 1881.
