Killed well with mud, pulled tubing and reran with hookwall packer to locate casing leak. Bridged hole below leak and re cemented 7" casing. Drilled out plug, tested casing with 1600# - no pressure losses. Perforated 2700-2900, 3100-3150, 3200-3300, 3400-3550, and 3570-3690' with 1 shot per foot, and dually completed to produce oil from Grayburg-San Andres oil zone and gas from the Eumont gas zone.
