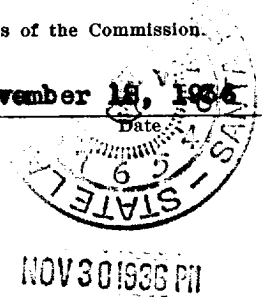

Additional information:

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3997' on November 13, 1936. The 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3994' and the well swabbed. The well was then acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. The acid set 6 hours and was swabbed out. The well flowed 189 barrels of clean oil on 24 hour test. Hourly average of 7 barrels. Flowing through 2 1/4" choke. Daily gas rate of 113,000. Gas oil ratio of 600. The well was then re-acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid set 6 hours and was swabbed out. The well flowed 229 barrels of clean oil on 12 hour test. Flowing through 1" open choke. Daily gas rate of 191,000. Gas oil ratio of 419.
