Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the N/2 of Section 21, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its Elbert Shipp Lease, a portion of which is located in the S/2 of the NW/4, W/2 of the NE/4 and SE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 21, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Humble Oil and Refining Company is owner and operator of oil and gas leases located in the W/2 of the NW/4 and the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 21, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Humble leases form the 320 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of the Elbert Shipp #1 located 1980 feet from the North and West lines of Section 21, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was completed in the present Eumont Gas Pool July 9, 1937. This well is presently assigned an 80-acre allowable.
- (3) Contingent upon obtaining Conservation Commission approval of this application for the non-standard 320-acre Gas Production Unit, Gulf Oil Corporation and Humble Oil and Refining Company have agreed to enter into a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement covering the above described 320 acres for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool Gas under such acreage and have agreed to use the Gulf Oil Corporation Elbert Shipp #1 as the Unit well.
