To workover well to increase production as follows:

1. Spot 100 gals. Dowell Jelly Seal on bottom and load hole with oil.
2. Treat with 750 gals. Dowell Jel Acid and 2000 gallons 15% LT acid.
3. Swab and place back on production as flowing well.

An increase of 20 barrels per day over the present 13 bbls. per day production is expected.
