Re: Exception to No-Flare Order  
for C. S. LONG No. 1 Huston,  
NE/4 of SW/4, Sec 21-19N-37E,  
Monument Field, Lea Co., N. M.

Gentlemen:

Please consider my application for an exception to the No-Flare Order (R-553) in the case of casinghead gas production from my No. 1 Huston well located as indicated above and on the accompanying plat. I request that I be allowed to flare the casinghead gas from this well.

I submit the following information in connection with this application:

- 1) Lease description: the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter (NE/4 of SW/4) of Section 21, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, N. M. P. M., containing 40 acres, more or less.
- 2) Productive formation: Grayburg.
- 3) Gas/Oil ratio of well to be excepted: 900/1.
- 4) The nearest gas pipeline, to the best of my knowledge, is a Warren Petroleum Corporation line about 1250 feet west of the LONG No. 1 Huston connection point.

Warren Petroleum Corporation has taken gas production tests on the subject well and has reported that it is not economically feasible to lay a line to take gas from it.

I have requested that Warren take production tests in the future on this well so that the gas may be saved when and if there is sufficient increase in the gas volume to justify a connection. Warren has agreed to perform such tests and any other related tests that we may request.
