6. Standard Oil Company of Texas executed a contract with Warren Petroleum Corporation on January 11, 1957, for sale of casinghead gas produced on the State 1-22 Lease. Under the terms of the contract Warren Petroleum Corporation agreed to furnish a pipe line for gathering the gas within 90 days of the contract execution date.

7. (a) The daily gas volumes to be flared or vented are estimated at 70 MCF for the State 1-22 4-C Well and 160 MCF for the State 1-22 3-F Well.

(b) Gas-oil ratio for the State 1-22 4-C Well is 1627 cubic feet per barrel and of the State 1-22 3-F Well is 3720 cubic feet per barrel. Warren Petroleum Corporation will construct a gas metering line to the lease for transmission to its Monument gasoline plant.

WHEREFORE, Standard Oil Company of Texas respectfully requests that this application be approved by administrative order in accordance with the provisions of Order R-520, as amended by Order R-553.

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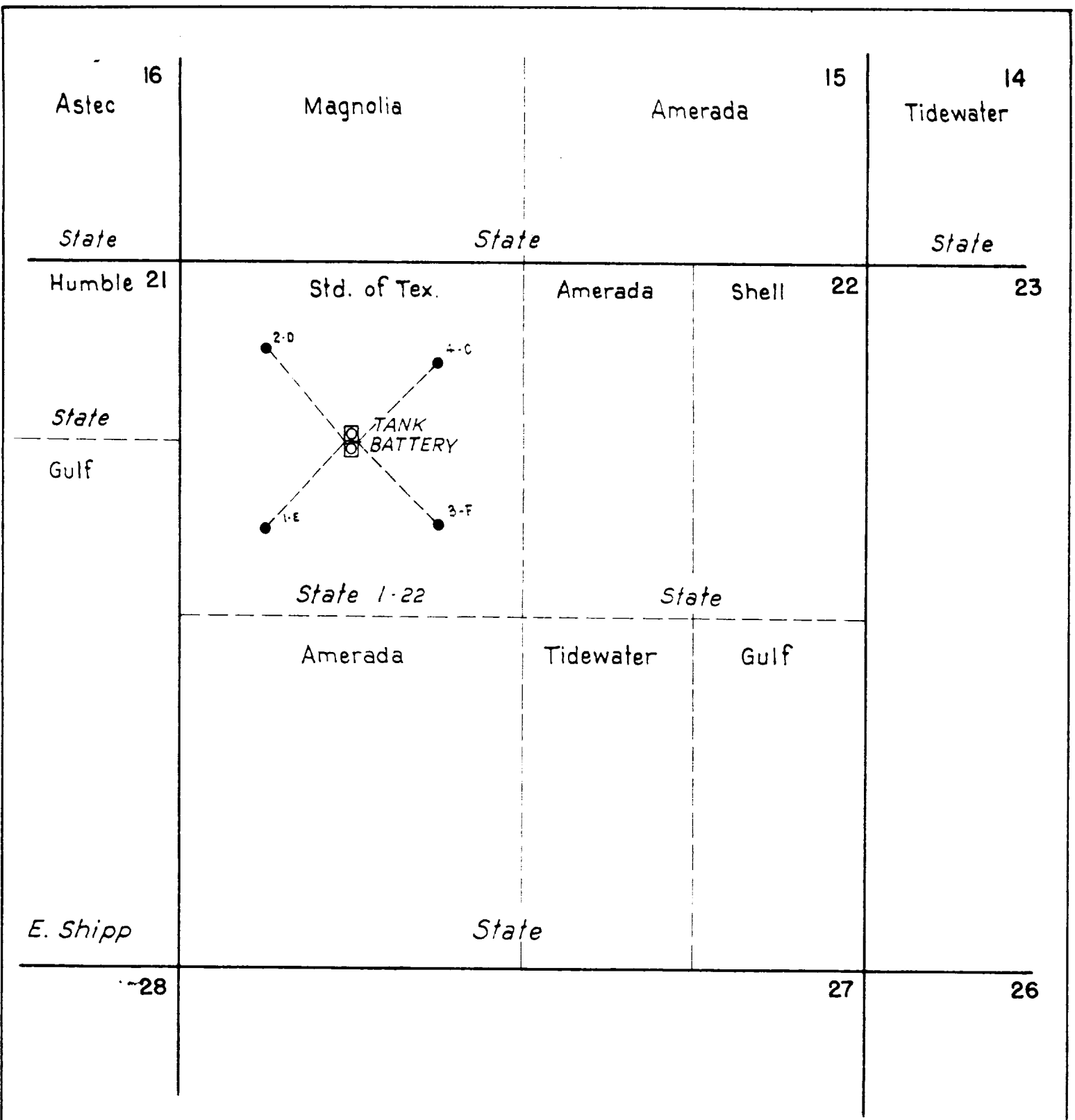
