DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

an 8-3/4" hole was drilled to a depth of 3600' and 7"-23lb. casing was cemented at that point with 135 sacks. The plug was down at 445 am 5-21-51. A Temperature survey indicated the top of cement to be at approximately 2820'. Cement was allowed to set 6 days before resuming drilling operations with cable tools. The casing was tested with 1000 psi pressure and found to be satisfactory.
