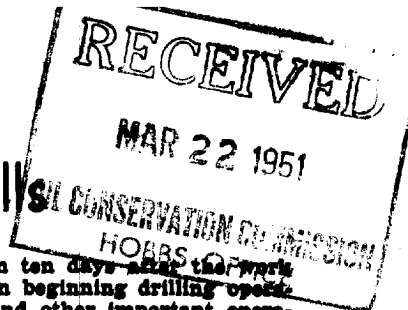

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

As specified on form C-102 submitted on 2-1-51 this well was deepened to 3739 by drilling the cement plug. An attempt to squeeze cement the interval 3710-38 was unsuccessful in that the squeeze packer would not seat. The well was then plugged back with plastic to 3697'. The plastic was subjected to 1000 psi pressure. Sour gas was not shut-off as planned, indicating sour gas coming from the interval 3660-90. The volume of gas was unchanged.
