DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 7 7/8" hole was drilled to 3600 and a 4 3/4" hole drilled to 3310. 5 1/2" 15.5 lb. casing was cemented at 3600 with 100 sacks. The plug was pumped down at 4:55 am 11-2-50. A temperature survey indicated the top of cement at approx. 2905. The cement was allowed to set 72 hours before further work was performed.
