DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After cementing 5 1/2" casing at 3600' the plug was drilled and the hole cleaned out to 3810' 300 quarts of SOWE No. 1 was placed from 3660 to 3810. Pea gravel and cal-seal was placed above the shot, the top of the Cal-seal being at 3565. The shot exploded on 11-17-50. The hole was then cleaned out to bottom.
