DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7" 24# 10-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 3615' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 100 sacks cement.

Casing and fitting were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand thirty minutes undisturbed. No drop in pressure resulted, and drilling was resumed.
