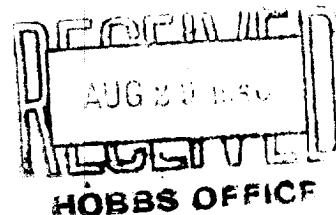

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3960' TD, Tested Casing with 800# for 30 mins was OK, and drilled out cement and went out of solid cement at 1600' and completely out of cement at 1645', and on August 24, 1946, tested Casing with 900# for 30 mins with Rotary tools and was OK. Took another test with Halliburton, 1200# for 30 mins was OK, drilled out bridging plug at 3483' and getting ready to plug back approximately 15' with Dowell Plastic.
