6-5/8" 20# New Electric welded casing was set in this well at 3819' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 100 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings will be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results, cement plug will be drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results, drilling will be resumed.
