Gentlemen:

Amerada Petroleum Corporation's State "P" No. 2, located 660' FSL and 660' FWL of Section 29, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed in July, 1936, as an oil well from open hole section 3805' to 3935' in the Monument Grayburg Pool. Commission Order No. R-302 dated March 31, 1953, granted Amerada permission to dually complete the well in the Monument Oil and Eumont Gas Pools. The actual dual completion work was done in November, 1953, with Eumont Gas perforations being from 3330' to 3360' and 3430' to 3600'.

After the well was completed, Amerada furnished the Commission copies of a 160 acre gas acreage plat along with Form No. C-104, Request for Allowable. The acreage requested was the full SW/4 of Section 29, T-19-S, R-37-E, composed of the Amerada State "P" Lease (80 acres) and the Amerada State "R" Lease (80 acres). By letter dated December 14, 1953, the Commission assigned the well 160 acres for allowable purposes. The well has been producing with a 160 acre allowable; however, the acreage has never been unitized.

By this letter of application, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an administrative order creating a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit for the Amerada State "P" No. 2, Eumont gas well, with acreage consisting of the Amerada State "P" Lease described as the W/2 SW/4 Section 29 and the Amerada State "R" Lease described as the E/2 SW/4 Section 29, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
