3935' T.D. - 8-5/8" csg set @ 2485'. 6-5/8" Csg set @ 3805'. Well originally completed July 11, 1936. Oil is being produced from the Monument Pool and is currently carried @ 40 bbls per day on the State Production Schedule. It is our intention to dual complete this well by perforating the 6-5/8" csg from 3330' to 3360' and from 3430' to 3600' and produce gas thru the csg from the Seven Rivers- Queens Sections. We will continue to produce oil thru the tbg from the Monument Section.
