DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Packer could not be pulled but stuck in hole. Whipstock was set 3630 and new hole drilled to 3930. 4 1/2 inch liner was set to line new hole to 30 feet in 7 inch casing and cemented in. Gun perforated 3906-3918 treated wash acid. Packer set 3896-3900, gun perforated, 3880-3896 treated wash acid. Tested well to flow approximately 15 BOPH at approximate G.O.R. of 2000/l.
