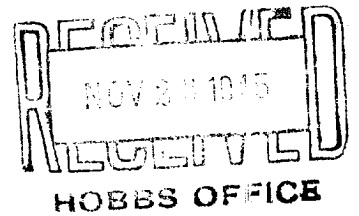

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-offs, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Equalized pressure in tubing and casing. Halliburton pumped in casing 8 barrels of packer seal composed of 3 sacks of Aquagl, 1 bale of Fibratx and 1 sack of Jell Flake. This was run to seal off gas apparently leaking around packer. Subsequent test show seal satisfaction.
