NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL

Notice is hereby given that the Commission has received an application for a permit to drill an oil well in the State of New Mexico. The location of the well is as follows: Section 32, Township 33N, Range 12E, County of Grant, State of New Mexico. The proposed well is to be drilled to a depth of 5000 feet. The Commission has reviewed the application and has determined that the proposed well meets the requirements of the Commission. The Commission has also determined that the proposed well is in compliance with the provisions of the Conservation Act. The Commission has therefore issued a permit to the applicant to drill the well. The permit is valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issuance. The applicant is required to file a report with the Commission within 60 days of the completion of the well. The report should contain a description of the well, the results of the drilling, and the amount of oil produced. The Commission reserves the right to suspend or revoke the permit if the applicant fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the permit. The Commission also reserves the right to require the applicant to post a bond to guarantee the performance of the well. The bond should be in the amount of \$100,000.00. The bond should be payable to the Commission. The Commission has also determined that the proposed well is in compliance with the provisions of the Conservation Act. The Commission has therefore issued a permit to the applicant to drill the well. The permit is valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issuance. The applicant is required to file a report with the Commission within 60 days of the completion of the well. 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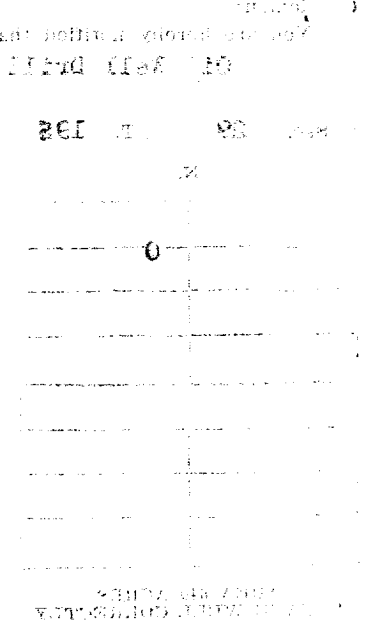
