DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

April 20, 1936 well was drilled to depth of 59' in surface sand. Returns were lost at 38', 16" OD casing was set and cemented at 47' with 100 sacks cement.

April 22, well was drilled to depth of 274' in redbed. 10-3/4" casing was set at 270' and cemented with 200 sacks cement.

April 24, cement plug was drilled out and casing bailed dry. Let set 2 hours and bailer again run and casing tested dry.
