DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

June 9, 1936. Well drilled to total depth of 2522' in anhydrite. 7-5/8" OD 26.40# new seamless casing was set at 2518' and cemented with 400 sacks.

June 13, 1936. 7-5/8" pipe was tested with 1200# pressure for 30 minutes before drilling plug. After drilling plug, pipe was again tested with 1200# pressure for 30 minutes. Pipe tested OK.
