## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# 8-thread. New Electric Welded Casing was set in this well at 2357' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 700 sacks cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand for thirty minutes undisturbed. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted and drilling was resumed.
