3915' Total and drilled out depth, Swabbed from 6PM to 6AM December 8, 1946 and made 50.80 barrels oil 44.86 barrels water Actual gauge of water taken from drawoff on storage tanks.

December 8, 1946 swabbed 7AM to 9AM made 18.77 barrels of Fluid, and shut in 9AM to 4PM and opened up at 4PM on 1" Choke Tubing Pressure 450# and flowed until 11PM and died and swabbed from 12Midnite until 7AM and actual gauge of 29.94 barrels oil 13.49 barrels water drawoff of storage tank, from 4PM to 7AM December 9, 1946.
