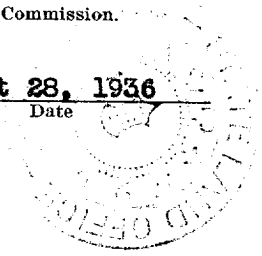

Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3910' and 3894' of 2 1/2" upset tubing set. The well was then swabbed in and would not flow. Well was flowed for with high pressure gas for 6 hours and produced 116 barrels oil. Through 1" open choke.

The well was then acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid went in under Maximum of 900# on tubing and Minimum of Vacuum. Set 6 hours. Swabbed in and flowed 392 barrels clean oil in 9-2/3 hours. Through 2 1/2" open tubing. Gas volume of 544,000. Gas oil ratio of 557.
