DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

12 1/2" 40# 8-thd. New Electric welded casing was set in this well at 161' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 150 sacks of cement.

Casing was drilled out and the bailer run to bottom and bailed the hole dry. The hole was then allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer was again run to bottom and then pulled to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so drilling was then resumed.
