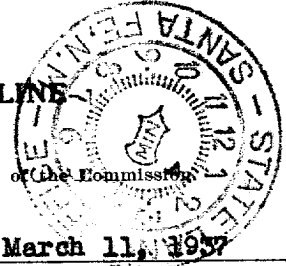

Permission is requested to connect Amerada Petroleum Corporation's Sarah Phillips Company or Operator Lease Wells No. 2 in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 33, T. 19, R. 37, N. M. P. M., Monument Field, Lea County, with the pipe line of the Texas Pipe Line Co. Pipe Line Co. Address

Status of land (State, Government or privately owned)

Location of tank battery 1320' from South. 1980' from West. Section 33 - 19 - 37

Description of tanks 2- High 500 barrel wrought iron tanks.

Logs of the above wells were filed with the Oil Conservation Commission March 11, 1937, 19

Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3910' and 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3897'. Well was acidized 4 times. First treatment of 2000 gallons of Dowell XX. Second treatment of 3000 gallons Dowell XX. Third treatment of 4000 gallons Dowell XX. Fourth treatment of 4000 gallons Dowell XX. The hole was shot with 180 quarts of Nitro from 3815'-3910'. Cleaned out to bottom. 24 hours production 189 bbls. clean oil. 3910' Total depth. Brown lime. Set 10 Williamson Flow Valves. Packer set at 3750' on 2 1/2" upset tubing. Well flowed 325 barrels clean oil on 26 hour test. Gas rate of 90,000.
