As specified on Form C-102 dated 4-30-51. this well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner.

The hole was filled with heavy mud and cement plugs spotted at the following depths:

- Bottom plug 3995-4095 (TD)
Base of salt 2600-2650
Base of anhydrite 2450-1500
Base of surface pipe 150-200
Surface plug 0-30

7-5/8" casing was pulled from 1120'. The well was capped and marked as prescribed in existing regulations.
