DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was spudded at 8:00 pm 3-16-51. A 13-3/4" hole was drilled to 157' and 10-3/4" 40 lb used casing was cemented at 150' with 100 sacks. Cement was circulated to the surface and the plug was down at 11:45 am 3-17-51. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours and pressure tested to 500 psi before resuming drilling operations.
