Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 as it pertains to Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 in the Burnet Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, we wish to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" Lease is comprised of 160 acres, located in the SW/4 of Section 2, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The No. 1 well is located 1980' FSL and 1980' FWL, Section 2, and was completed as a gas well March 21, 1955. The gas-oil ratio on this well declined and on October 12, 1956, a repeat test on the well indicated production of 44.8 barrels oil, 177.5 MCF gas in 8 hours, giving a gas-oil ratio of 3962 to 1.
2. The subject well was given an oil allowable effective October 15, 1956. The flowing pressures on this well are no longer great enough to permit gas sales to the gas gathering system now serving the well.
3. A low pressure gas gathering system operated by Warren Petroleum Corporation is presently located approximately 1 1/4 miles from this lease. An extension of this system is scheduled within the next sixty days and a connection to the Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 will be made at that time.
4. A plat showing the well location, offset ownership and tank battery location is attached.

It is respectfully requested that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 as it pertains to Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 in the Ramon Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, we wish to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 lease is comprised of 160 acres, located in the SW 1/4 of Section 2, T-20-S, R-37-W, Lea County, New Mexico. The No. 1 well is located 1800' EBL and 1800' NW, Section 2, and was completed as a gas well March 11, 1955. The gas-oil ratio on this well declined and on October 12, 1956, a recompletion test on the well indicated production of 14.8 barrels oil, 147.3 MCF gas in 8 hours, giving a gas-oil ratio of 10.0 to 1. The subject well was given an oil allowable effective October 12, 1956. The flowing pressures on this well are no longer great enough to permit gas sales to the gas gathering system now serving the well.
  2. A low pressure gas gathering system operated by Warner Petroleum Corporation is presently located approximately 1 1/2 miles from this lease. An extension of this system is scheduled within the next sixty days and a connection to the Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 will be made at that time.
  3. A plot showing the well location, offset ownership and tank battery location is attached.
- In view of the foregoing statements and to keep the well on production to protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order R-553 for a volume of approximately 155 MCF per day, which will be vented from the Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" No. 1 pending a connection to a low pressure gas gathering system.
