Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 as it pertains to Cities Service Oil Company State "All" No. 1 in the Busint Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, we wish to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company State "AR" Lease is comprised of 160 acres, lecated in the SMA of Section 2, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Medica. The No. 1 well is located 1980' FSL and 1980' FWL, Section 2, and was completed as a gas well March 21, 1955. The gas-oil ratio on this well declined and on October 12, 1956, a repetential test on the well indicated production of the harmals at 177 5 MCP declined and on Ostober 12, 1756, a repetential test on the well indicated production of 44.8 barrels oil, 177.5 MCF gas in 8 hours, giving a phonoil ratio of 3962 to 1.

2. The subject well was given an oil allowable effective Ostober 15, 1956. The floring pressures on this well are no longer great enough to punit gas sales to the gas gathering system new serving the well.
