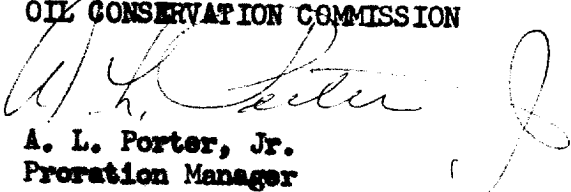
Dear Sir:

Upon advice that you were doing a formation fracture job on your Cooper A #1-C 3-20-37 in the Monument pool several days ago we granted you an advance allowable of 200 barrels for the purpose of testing. At that time we advised you that report of results of the fracture operation on Form C-103 and Form C-116 reporting the results of the gas oil ratio test should be filed as soon as possible after the tests were taken following the recovery of the load oil. To date we have not received the requested reports and would like to remind you that any request for an increase in allowable as a result of fracturing will become effective upon the date that Form C-116 is received in this office.
