FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

It was intended to drill and complete Laughlin #5 as a dual gas-oil well in the Dumont Gas Pool and the Blinebry Oil Pool. Approval to do this was granted by Commission Administrative Order DC-4 dated July 28, 1953. The Blinebry oil zone was tested through perforations from 5675'-5692'; 5700'-5712'; and open hole from 5713' to 5743' and found to be dry of commercial oil production. A Baker CI bridge plug was set at 5600' and one sack (8') of cement dumped on top of the plug, giving a plug back of depth of 5592'.

Verbal approval is requested that the above Administrative Order DC-4 be allowed to stand so that a dual gas-oil completion can be made between the Dumont Gas Pool and the Paddock (pool undesignated). It is proposed to perforate and test Paddock zone.
