12 1/8" 40# 8-thd. New Lapweld casing was set in this well at 202' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 145 sacks of cement.

Casing was drilled out to bottom. And bailer was run and the hole bailed dry. The hole was then allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer was again run to bottom to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so the drilling was then resumed.
