

DETAILS OF WORK (Continued):

(1) Gas from the bradenhead on Britt A-6 No. 4 has a sulphur content of 300 grains per 100 cubic feet of gas.

(2) Sulphur content of Britt A-6 No. 1, an oil well in the regular Monument Pay, is 1361 grains per 100 cubic feet.

(3) Gas produced from the Monument-Paddock in the Texas Company-Phillips No. 6 tested 1260 grains per 100 cubic feet.

The bradenhead has an estimated open flow potential of 3,000 MCF per day and a shut-in pressure of 1060.

The gas will be sold to the Warren Petroleum Company after being used for gas lift and will be reported monthly on Form C-115.
