DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 13 joints 275' of 12-3/4" OD 50# Line Pipe SS Casing. Set and cemented at 291' w/350 sacks Regular El Toro Neat cement. Plug at 270'. Maximum pressure 250#. Circulated approximately 20 sacks cement.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 12-3/4" casing w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 270' to 291', tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector preparations were made to drill ahead.
