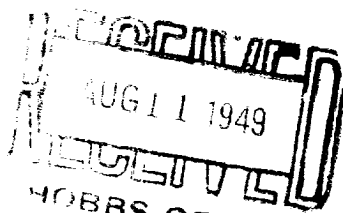

TD: 326 - Red Beds

Ran 305' (11 Jts) 13-3/8" casing at 322'. Cemented with 325 sacks.
Cement circulated. Completed 9:50 AM, 8-2-49.
Tested casing before drilling cement plug with 800# for 1 hour, no drop in pressure. Encountered hard cement at 280'. Commenced drilling cement plug at 10:00 PM, 8-3-49. Drilled Cement plug and 6' below pipe. Tested hole with 600# and fluid was lost to formation. No evidence of leaks observed at surface. Drilling proceeded.
