Gentlemen:

We recently reentered and recompleted as a Eumont (Gas) producer the previously plugged and abandoned Graham Royalty, Ltd. - Laughlin No. 4 (now Doyle Hartman - Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4) located 660' FNL and 660' FEL (A), Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Due to the potential water problems that exist in the Eumont (Gas) zone in this area, the reentry of the existing wellbore provided the most economical approach and also eliminated the unnecessary waste of drilling a new well.

We hereby request administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4 to the existing 280-acre non-standard Eumont (Gas) proration unit consisting of the SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, both in T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico along with the previously existing Britt-Laughlin Com No. 1 (C-08-20S-37E) and Britt-Laughlin Com No. 6 (I-05-20S-37E). The current proration unit was created by NMOCD Force Pooling Order R-9199 dated June 15, 1990.

Three copies of a color-coded land map outlining the subject 280-acre Eumont (Gas) proration unit, as well as the location of our existing wells and the Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4 reentry, are enclosed for your review. Supplementing the enclosed color-coded land plat is a companion table describing by tract number all Eumont (Gas) proration units (including the operators of the Eumont rights) that offset the Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4.

Complete copies of this application have also been sent by certified mail to all offsetting parties owning Eumont (Gas) rights as described

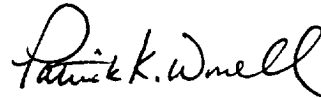

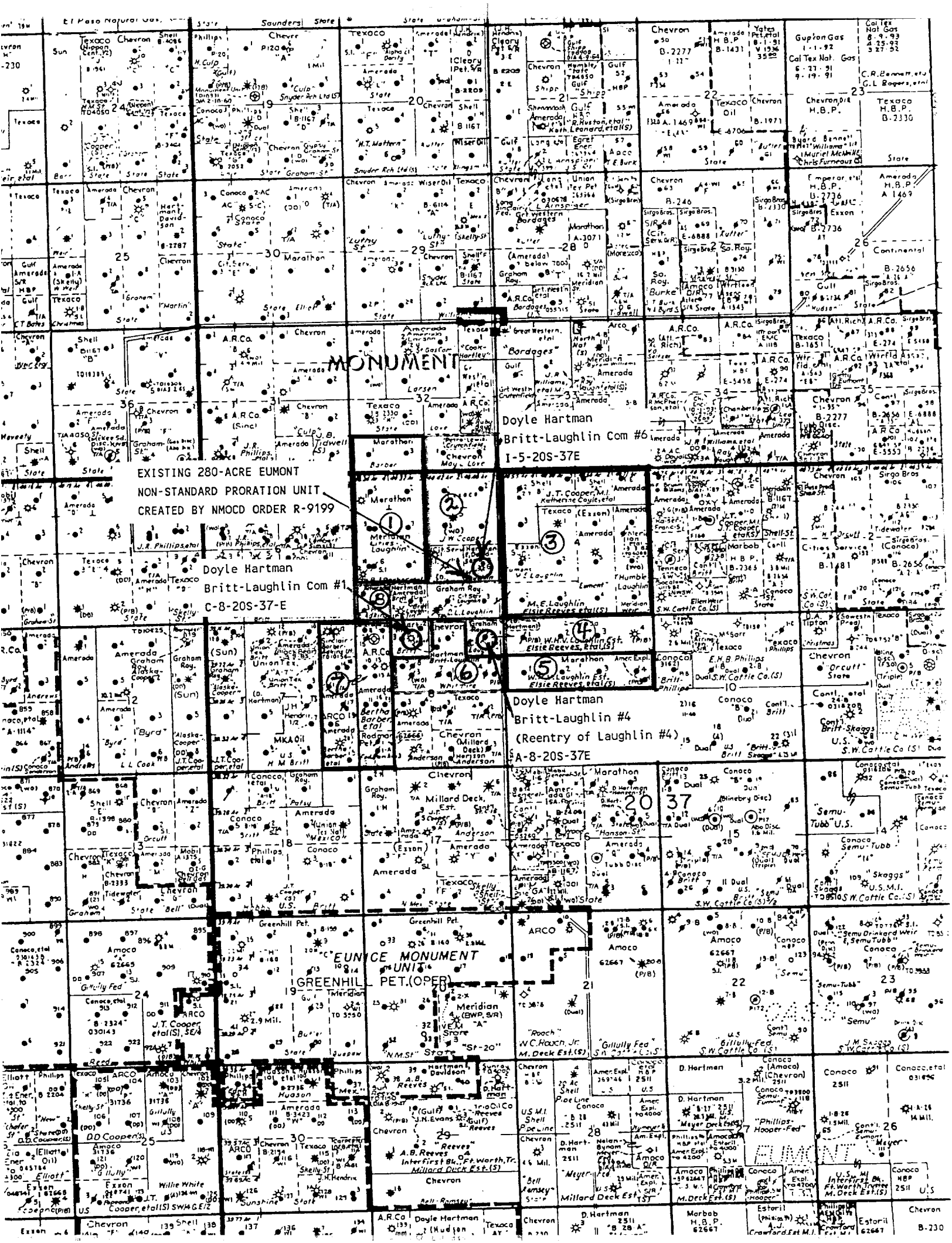

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the attached April 22, 1991 letter requesting administrative approval for simultaneous dedication of our Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4 reentry to the existing 280-acre non-standard Eumont (Gas) proration unit consisting of the SE/4, SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5 and the NE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, T-20-s, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico along with the existing Britt-Laughlin Com No. 1 and Britt-Laughlin Com No. 6. Also attached is the letter we received from Mr. Jerry Sexton on April 29, 1991 notifying us of our need for approval of a non-standard location. We were previously unaware that the Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4 located 660' FNL and 660' FEL (A), Section 7, t-20-S, R-37-E, was a non-standard location under the Eumont (Gas) Pool regulations.

In light of this, we hereby request that this letter be made an addendum to our previous letter dated April 22, 1991 and we respectfully request administrative approval of a non-standard Eumont (Gas) location for our Britt-Laughlin Com No. 4. As mentioned in our previous application, we reentered this wellbore to avoid the unnecessary waste of drilling a new well.

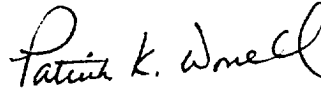

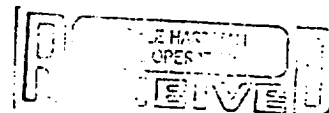
Also, in the future please submit your intent to re-enter prior to commencing work. This intent was submitted after-the-fact along with completion reports.
