## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5700 TD

Set 5 1/2" casing @ 5700' and cemented with 400 sacks of common cement. 7 centralizers from 5513 to 5700 and 7 centralizers from 5113 to 5323.

Let cement set 72 hours and tested with 750# pump pressure, Drilled cement plug to 5697 and betested with 750#. No decrease in pump pressure.

Perforated 5 1/2" casing with 164 - 1/2" jet shots from 5655 to 5696.

Acidized with 500 gallons of 20% Mud acid by The Western Co., well flowed without swabbing 22 Barrels of load oil, 12 barrels of acid water, 726 barrels of new oil in 12 hours.
