
The Ohio Oil Company respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico grant this application of Ohio for authorization to dually complete its W. H. Laughlin No. 3, located in Section 9, Township 20-S, Range 37-E, now producing in the Monument Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Ohio desires to dually complete this well in the Yates, Seven Rivers, and Queens gas pay zone in such a manner as to produce gas through the annulus between the casing and the tubing, and to continue producing Monument oil through the tubing. The Ohio intends to install an efficient packer and to perform the completion so as to prevent waste in either reservoir. A schematic diagram showing the proposed method for dual completion is attached, as well as a map showing the location of the Ohio lease with the leases of offset operators. Each of these offset operators has been notified of this application.

Subsequent to completion of the work, Ohio will present data showing the detailed completion program as well as plans for future testing which will be made regularly to determine that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.
