On company test well made 55 barrels first hour, 55 barrels the second hour and 55 barrels the sixth hour. Well was then treated with 4,000 gallons Dowell X Acid Solution on June 11, 1935. The well was shut in and left shut in 24 hours. The well was then swabbed in. On Company test well made, one hour through tubing, 115 barrels, one hour through casing and tubing, 205 barrels.
