- Will drill with the intention of encountering commercial oil at approximately 4050'.
- Will spud and set conductor by cable tool method and complete by rotary method.
- Will cement approximately 200' 16" 70# conductor.
- Will cement 9-5/8" 40# Grade D API Seamless casing thru first gas and oil after testing at approximately 3200'.
- Will set and cement approximately 4000' 6-5/8" 26# Grade API casing on top of oil horizon.
