FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Form C-102 submitted on February 19, 1954, requested permission to plug well. We now desire to recomplete well in the Yates formation as a gas well in the following manner:

Set a drillable bridging plug at 2985 feet and spot eight gallons of Hydromite on top of plug. Perforate 7" casing from 2818 to 2868 feet with 2 bullets per foot, and wash perforation with 500 gallons of acid. Also, fracture formation with 6000 gallons of crude oil carrying 3000 pounds of sand, if necessary.
