DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was treated with 1,000 gallons 30% commercial Hydrochloric acid solution on November 9th. The well was shut in and left shut in for forty eight hours, until November 11th, when it was scrubbed in. During the first twenty four hours the well made 280 barrels of oil with 215,000 cubic feet of gas. The second twenty four hours the well made 254 barrels of oil with 245,000 cubic feet of gas. The well has now been placed on an allowance based on 40% acreage and 60% potential which allows it 132 barrels daily.
