DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A Guiberson Spiral Tubing Packer for 3" A.P.I. 10thd., Upset was run inside 6-5/8" 26# casing to make water shut off. The packer was set at 4075' and test was made showing water to be shut off. The well was swabbed to 1400' then started flowing. An hour test gauged 14 1/2 Barrels 15% B.S. & W. At 6 A. M. 8/21/33 an hour test gauged 15 barrels with 3% B.S. & W. thru 19/64 choke the tubing pressure 225# casing pressure 450#. At 12 A.M. the well was making pipe line oil.
