DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 21, 1944 at 6:00 A.M., 84 hours had elapsed since setting 2780' of 9 5/8" OD Casing which was tested as follows: A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, after which the cement plug was drilled and casing shut off was again tested by building up 1000# pressure and held for thirty minutes. As both tests were OK, drilling operations were resumed.
