## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:00 P.M. September 6, 1944, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 21 1/2 feet of 13" Surface Casing which was tested as follows: A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, after which the cement plug was drilled with casing shut off, was again tested by building up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. As both tests were OK, drilling operations were resumed.
